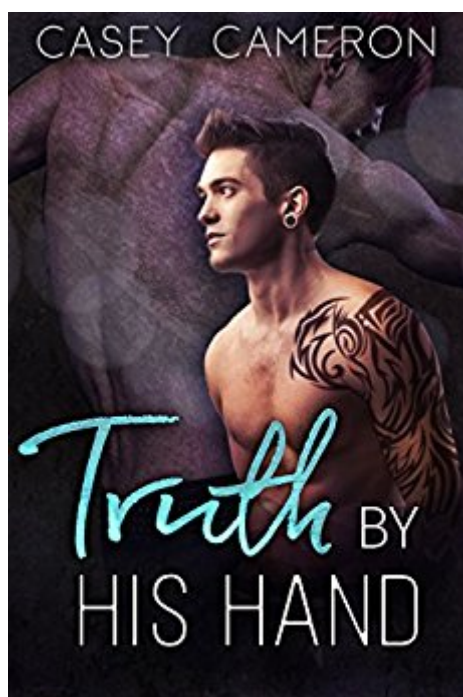


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Truth By His Hand

This review is being written right after I finished this book, because the feelings I'm experiencing are that intense. This book describes the initial BDSM experience and what could go wrong almost perfectly, at least based on what I've experienced. There are some triggers in this book that are expertly handled and addressed, and I give huge kudos to Casey Cameron for writing such an emotionally charged book. I honestly didn't know what this book was about before reading it. I've read so many other books by this author that I chomped at the bit to get an ARC. I can't express all of my feelings and opinions without delving into my personal experiences, which I will not do. However, I definitely second this book to anyone in, interested in, or just wanting a very realistic look into the D/s relationship.

Now, I am not a huge fan of BDSM tropes, however, I loved this book. It's what I would describe as light to somewhat or maybe a tad bit of medium BDSM in comparison to the other levels that range higher and more aggressive. I rather loved the way the story began. We meet River (the story is told from his perspective, I would have liked to have had Ellison's perspective but I don't think the 1 POV detracted from the book) in a speed kink dating. River has dabbled in some aspects of BDSM but he is mostly inexperienced when it comes to that world. He knows he wants someone to take control and perhaps shake up his preconceptions of what being a DOM and SUB entails. River at first believes in the old stereotype that any DOM would have to be a big, intimidating, bear of a man. Yet, you know that saying? "You can't judge a book by its cover". Ellison may be shorter than the towering hulking mass that River had envisioned in a DOM, but he's just as much in control as any other good DOM. I loved Ellison. I loved what he brought out in River. This wasn't about the sex or necessarily the experience but rather showing something to someone that may have been missing from their lives in an educational way. Don't expect this to be reminiscent of the whole Fifty Shades of Grey nonsense. That gave a bad reputation to an already targetted lifestyle. This was written in a way that suggests that the author did his/her research. That I respect. That I can appreciate. I loved that it was a slow burn. It started off as a friendship and developed into something incredibly beautiful in its intimacy. I can picture River and Ellison together and it brings a smile to my face because it's not about what you may think a person can or cannot do or is capable of doing,

based merely on their appearance. I like how this broke that stereotype and made not just the character of River open his eyes, but so too the reader.

This is one of the best books I have read this year and definitely the best BDSM themed novel I have read since finishing the Deviation series by Chris Owen years ago. Casey Cameron is just a brilliant writer and she created this gem for which I can't be grateful enough. This is an extremely well written book. The characters are unique, they have depth and layers. River's self discovery is beautifully portrayed and his chemistry with Ellison is one of the best I have ever read. Their journey together is a thing of true beauty, you definitely shouldn't miss. If you enjoy BDSM with great characters, a gripping build up, sizzling hot chemistry and the most sensual relationship imaginable, this is a perfect read for you. Highly recommended.
