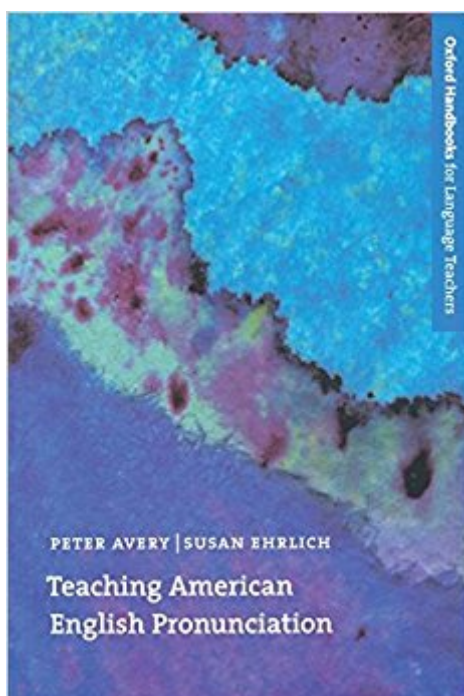


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Teaching American English Pronunciation (Oxford Handbooks For Language Teachers Series)
