This is a lovely, emotional romance. On the cover we have Lane, firefighter who loves his job. He is moving on from finding his boyfriend/fiancÃ©screwing someone else in their bed. He wants a "one and only" kind of love. Kevin is a Lawyer who advocates for children's rights and adoptions. He's got green eyes and dark blonde hair, and very low self esteem in social situations, because his mother was verbally abusive, and he's been drugged and raped in college. He longs for a man to love, and have a real, solid normal life. He and Lane have seen each other previously, but now they have a chance to get together at a party. Wonderful characters, an interesting story that will engulf you, and their sex is super steamy. Because Kevin can't remember what happened to him years ago, it will be his first time with everything. Lane is the perfect man for Kevin. He's patient, caring, and smitten by the shy Kevin. They hang out, talk, and slowly have their sweet romance. Meanwhile Lane's sister shows up on his doorstep pregnant and a mess, she doesn't want her baby. She's a real tornado of chaos. We have passion, devotion, and a hopeful future for our men. I'm really enjoying this series and love all the interactions among current and previous MC's. I rated this book lower than the first two for some items that I couldn't ignore. 1. There were a lot more grammar, punctuation and word errors in this one. They all had these issues but this one was a lot worse and interfered with my reading, drawing my attention to them more. 2. The foster care parents having a lawyer to fight bio parents. This absolutely would not happen. The residency of the child is determined by children services, the prosecutor who is the legal representative of children services, possibly a therapist, and a judge. If a foster parent ever attempted to interfere in reunification plans like this, the kids would be removed from their home immediately and the foster parents would lose their license. Foster care is an important issue and I'm happy when it's discussed in books but it's so important to portray it accurately. 3. Confidentiality. You are legally not allowed to even confirm a child is in care let alone share all that information about them. Additionally, I can't believe a lawyer would be so willing to share confidential information about his clients. If so, I can't imagine he's a lawyer long. As I said, I do enjoy this series and look forward to the next book.

Oh my goodness! I loved Carter and Alvin. Loved Teddy and Josh...however...Kevin and Lane are my absolute favorites! I fell for them both so hard. They were so perfect for each other! I hope we will see a book about Jordan next. Jenny's books just keep getting better!

Unfortunately a main character is unrepentantly and unselfcritically anti-choice. Spoiler: His sister is devastated about her pregnancy and wants an abortion. She turns to him for help, and his first thoughts are about how he'll miss out on loving a child. When she has a sonogram, his first thought is about his love for the child that doesn't exist. While he's thinking about his own needs (news flash! This song isn't about you), his sister is terrified when she finds out she's in her third trimester and can't legally abort; his response to that? He and the doctor agree to commit her to psychiatric care without her permission for three days. That's right, a woman who wants an abortion is treated as if she were mentally ill. The book suggests we should feel sympathy for the brother because he's a gay man. I don't see why. His penis and bank account seem fully capable of creating or adopting his own child without forcing his sister to use her body to incubate a family for him to love. It's sick to treat a woman like that. Perfect example of supposedly "pro life" thinking that devastates, infantilizes (to set up the whole scenario she asks him to make her a grilled cheese sandwich just like when he helped to raise her as a child), and dehumanizes a very much alive (and adult) woman's life. To do so for the sake of a lonely man to whom she's turned for help is sick.

This story is a nice addition to the series. I would have liked to see a bit more hashing out of Kevin's background...throughout the story Lane indicates he's going to revisit the different reactions Kevin has to events but that never occurs during the course of the book. It's a bit disappointing since you never really see Kevin heal. Not to say there isn't a HEA just that there is so much focus on Lane's family situation that Kevin story becomes almost an after thought.

What a story!! Cammie's story, had me seriously thinking of all the woman that have gone through or that are going through similar situation that she experienced. I love the love of these heroes!!

I found this book to be good reading. The growth of Kevin to a secure man to be very interesting. Not very happy with the Cammie situation. I liked the firemen interaction.

I have fallen in love with Jenny Wood's Unlikely Hero series! All of these books have come with their own set of broken guys who needed a hero. Such great reads! The only complaint I have for all of

them are that they are simply not long enough! Loved this book and all of them so far
