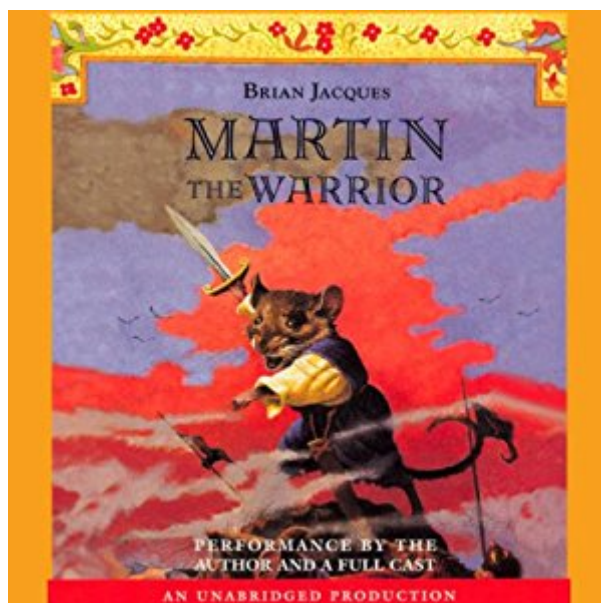

This is quite possibly the best book in the entire "Redwall" series. It is set in a time and place before

the founding of Redwall Abbey, and has all the elements of a good story. It has conflict, treachery, romance, adventure, and what might even be perceived as a dash of satire at points. Above all, his characters are more original and memorable in this than in most other "Redwall" books (particularly Felldoh and Grumm). These elements, combined with a unique ending, make for a tale that is equally enjoyable to readers of all ages. In short, this is the mark of a great author.
