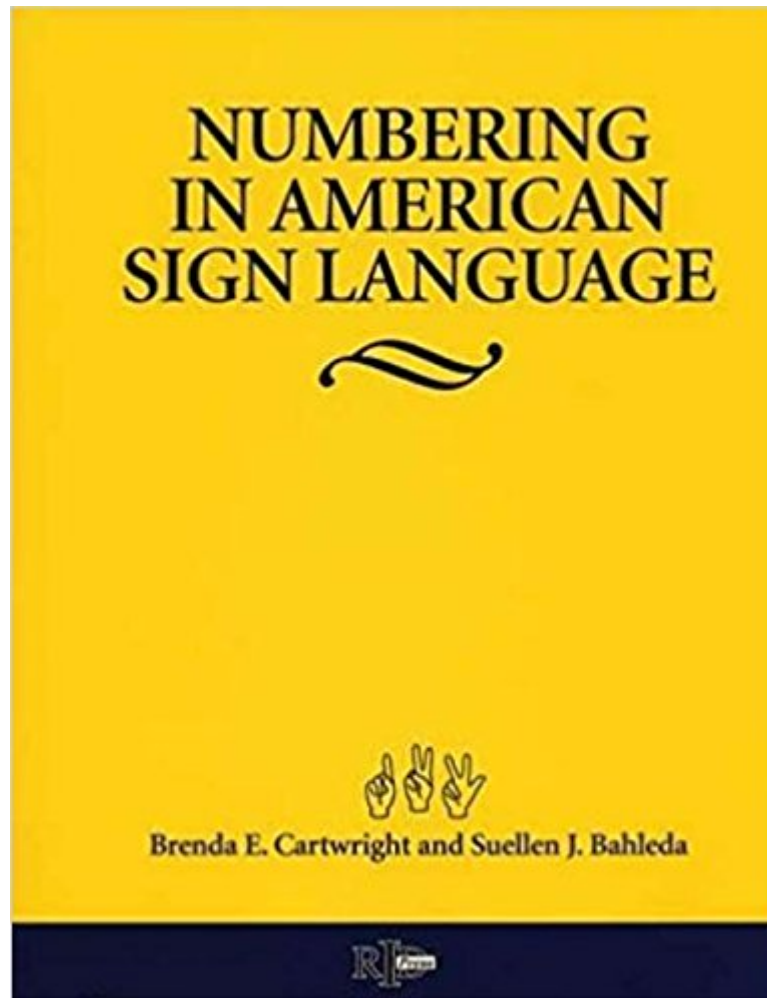

I found this book to be very helpful in working on producing numbers in American Sign Language. There are number drills, activities, warm ups, and more. It can be used on your own, but I preferred using it with someone else. This way you can take turns using your expressive and receptive skills. Thinking of numbers off the top of my head doesn't challenge me as much because I then have more time to think about what number I need to sign and am then able to do so without any challenge. Having these lists of numbers combined with fingerspelling and signing forced me to work on producing the correct number more quickly.
