Handy pocket set! I wish it had clindamycin on it and update recommendations for empiric antibiotic for gallbladder and other biliary tract diseases. (There is a lot of amp/sulbactam resistance so it is no longer the first line therapy). It's a little out of date, but otherwise a handy pocket tool.
