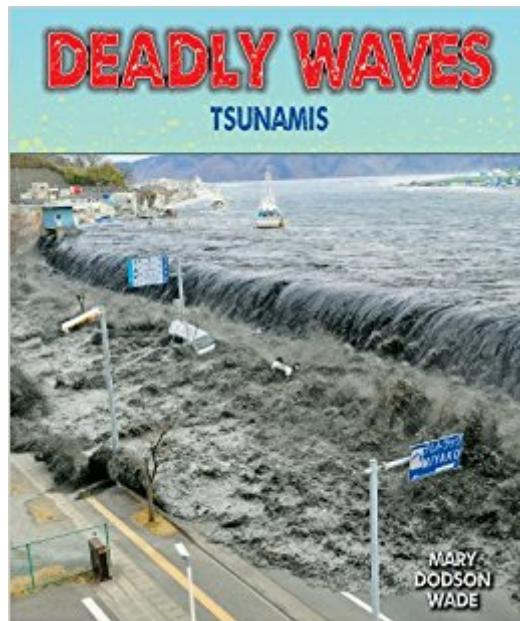




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Deadly Waves: Tsunamis (Disasters-People In Peril)
