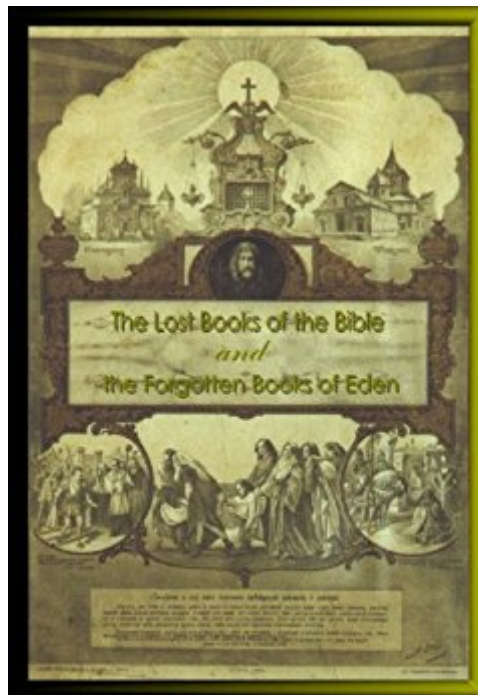


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The Lost Books Of The Bible And The Forgotten Books Of Eden: Banned Books From The Bible
