

Peter E. Gillquist is an archpriest and chairman of the Department of Missions and Evangelism for the Antiochian Orthodox Church of North America. He is a popular speaker and author, and is publisher of Conciliar Press. In the 1960's he was regional director for Campus Crusade for Christ. He has authored numerous books, including *Love is Now* and *Coming Home*.

Well-written and clear. I read this because I was curious about the social phenomenon of the conversion of so many American Evangelicals to Eastern Orthodoxy. I don't know much about

Christian theology, and some of the debates went way over my head, but nevertheless, the basic plot was clear. Very interesting, and a lot shorter than I had expected.

So far, I am loving this. As a former Baptist who is pursuing the Orthodox faith, the author is very relatable and addresses everything that I currently wonder coming from an evangelical background as he did. Definitely a must read for anyone who wants to know the "why" behind the Orthodox ways. Totally explains the history and reasoning behind liturgy. Love this book! Seems like it was written for me.

Good story and overview of Orthodox church. Section 3 is just his life story and just politics. I wasn't really interested in that part and skipped over most of it.

This explains why so many Christians are searching for the Ancient Church of Christ, the historic Church that began at Pentecost, complete and including the traditions in worship and living every day. Peter Gillquist was among the first of those in the 70's that set out to evangelize people to bring them to Christ, then realized they still had a long journey of their own to "go home".

I've long been intrigued by the Orthodox faith. It was refreshing to read of others who have journeyed before me and wrestled with similar questions.

I was seeking to learn more about Orthodoxy and this book was perfect. He writes not only of his own personal story, but answers many significant theological questions along the way. This book was completely satisfying.

Fr. Gillquist has a easy free flowing way of telling his story to becoming Orthodox. This was a fascinating book to read that, while an enjoyable read, provided wonderful information. There was no finger pointing, no commanding, just the story of a man's honest search for the truth. Very highly recommended!
