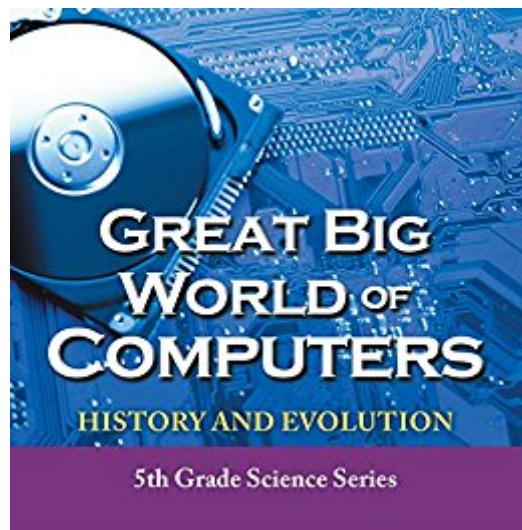

Nothing else in the book. Nothing! Few pictures illustrating this "smart" publication aren't even labeled or described. How this "masterpiece" can educate a fifth grader is beyond me. Fifth grader is a youngster of ten or eleven. Most of them at that age are already reluctant to learn. The inborn curiosity and need to know, already gave way to the need to pretend, they don't care about learning. (If your kid still hungers learning, count your

blessings). But they aren't stupid. They want to know, and they want you to tell them. You just have to be careful how you do it. Plus, in the era of the smartphones, they already know a lot about computers. They want to be hackers, they want to design their own computer games, they want to know all, preferably within next five minutes. They need to be told everything in the right order, right speed and right way. This book is a joke.
