

I have really enjoyed doing the projects out of this book. Most if not all of the designs make excellent gifts. One other thing I have found about this person's designs vs. others is that they don't seem to go out of style as a toy. Some other scrolling designs for children's puzzles seem to either be kind of old or the toy becomes forgotten. These designs and puzzles seem to make wonderful gifts (which I have done) that can last for years. I also recommend following the authors use of different woods for different designs. I made the polar bear out of aspen as the book suggested and it really did fit well with a white bear. I have not attempted to finish it for fear of a color change due to a finish. I now also use Tung Oil to finish ALL of my scrolling projects as the author. It really does bring out the color of the wood. Great book, can't say enough about it.
