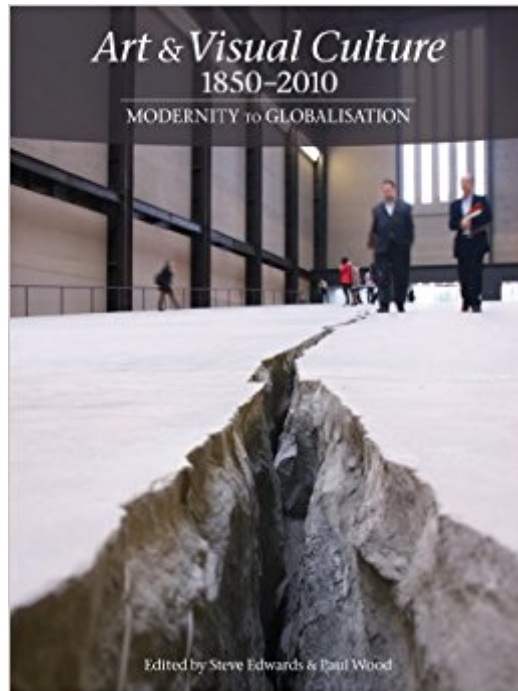




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Art & Visual Culture 1850-2010: Modernity To Globalization
