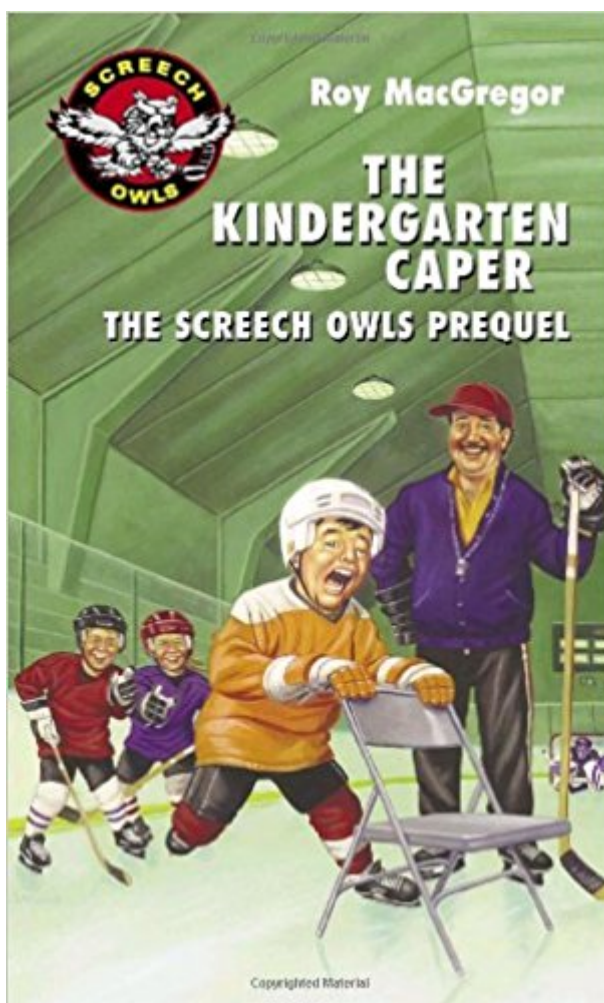


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The Kindergarten Caper: The Screech Owls Prequel (Screech Owl Mysteries)
