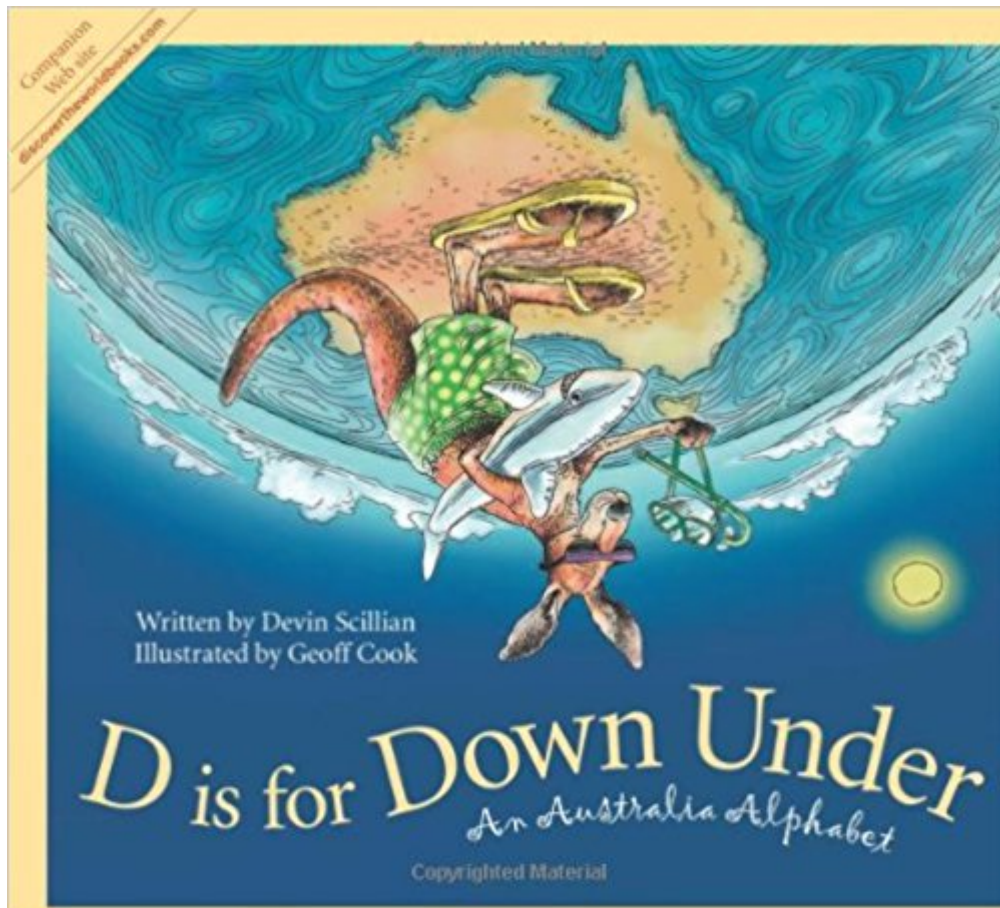

Nice facts in the margin in addition to the text. I liked that the author had a touch of humor and fun in the short rhymes on each page. The items for each letter were very well chosen and I really got a well rounded sense of Australia and its culture. My biggest con is that the artwork is not as good as in other books I own of a similar style. The people in particular are cartoony and at times rather repulsive. In particular, think how they drew the Aborigine on the letter D page was inexcusable - it seemed to mock them instead of show them the respect they deserve. I also think how the children were drawn on the letter E page were too stereotypical on steroids. If it was not for my issue with the artwork, I would probably have given the book 5 stars. As minor con is that I also do not like that some letters have two page spreads and some only one page. I wish all the letters were treated the same for consistency and because its difficult to see two-page spreads as some of the image is always lost in the middle. Here are the letters: A- Aborigine B- Beaches C- Crocodile D- Didgeridoo E- Echidna F- Freedom G- Great Barrier Reef H- Harbor (in Sydney) I- Island J- Jackaroo K- Kangaroos, Koalas, Kookaburras L- Lifeguards M- Mate N- Ned Kelly (a famous outlaw) O- Outback P- Perth Q- Qantas (airline) R- Rainbow Serpent (a key figure in Aborigine folklore) S- Southern Cross (constellation) T- Tennis U- Uluru V- Vegemite W- Waltzing Matilda (most famous folk song) X- X-games Y- Yabber and Yobbo Z- Zest (talks about Australian cultural and pride)
