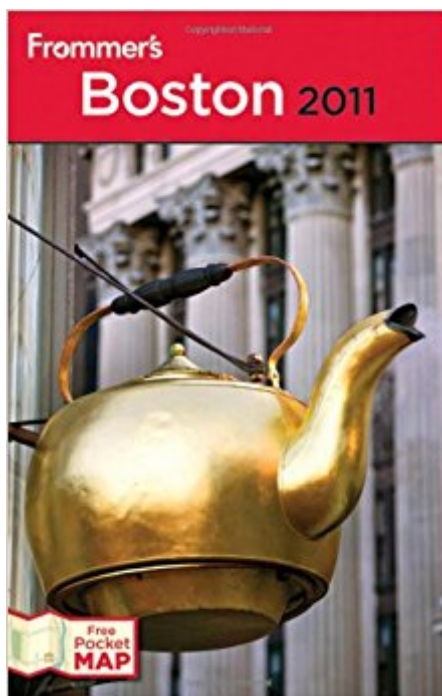

This is a kindle version specific review. I have not looked at the paper version. First I could not find a table of contents for this book in the kindle version which is critical to reviewing this book. Not sure if nonfiction books regularly lack TOCs but you can imagine it seems particularly important for a book like this. Second, if there is no TOC, have the "activities" of boston AFTER where to stay and where to eat was very annoying. I had to surf through both of those sections to get to the activities section. Overall a nonfiction piece such as this without a table of contents is limited since I don't/won't read this like a novel, especially when I want to go back and reference something. The text itself seems comprehensive of hotels based on my current limited knowledge of boston.-----Edit: So I was finally able to find the TOC for this kindle book by going to the "first page" and then moving one over. When searching, TOC is however blanked out. Not sure why/how

I missed this page during my first read through. I would still stand by my thoughts on arranging activities before all of the hotel/restaurant info.

As I am fairly new to Boston and have frequent out of town guests, I have accumulated all the big name Boston guidebooks. But I mostly end up leaving the books on the shelf except one -- Frommer's. The descriptions are useful and accurate yet the book doesn't get bogged down in some of the meaningless "noise" of some of the bigger books. This book was obviously written by someone who knows Boston inside and out and who has actually been to the places she writes about (definitely not the case with some of the other guidebooks). The map fold-out at the back is a life-saver. Kudos to Frommer's and the author/editor for this great book.

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
