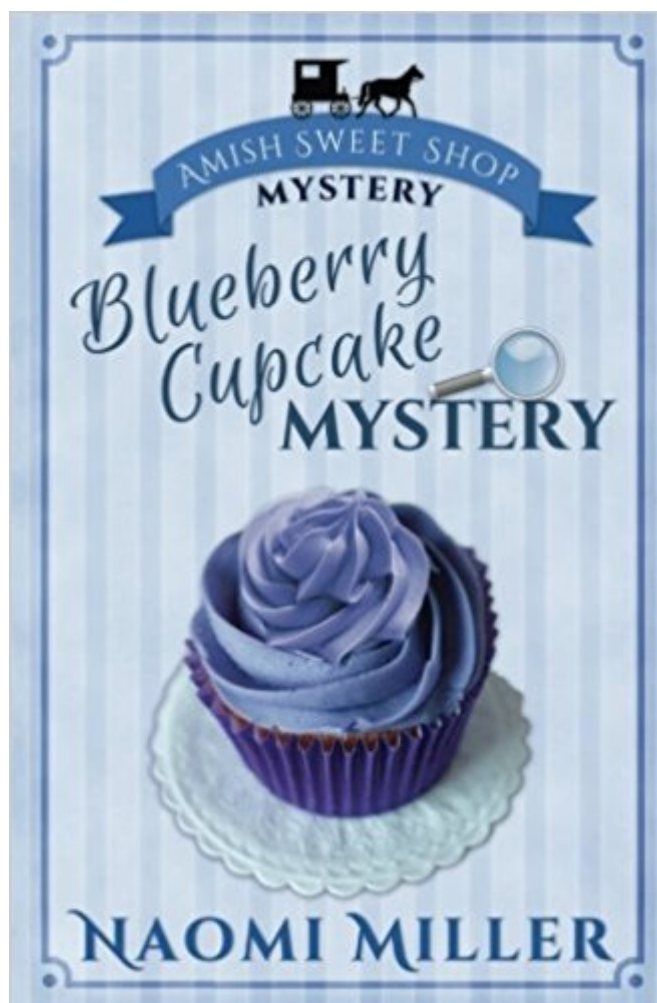


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Blueberry Cupcake Mystery (Amish Sweet Shop Mystery) (Volume 1)

My Thoughts and Review This was the first book that I have read by this author. I was very pleased with it. I love books that have great descriptions that make me feel like I am standing there watching the story unfold. The description of the bakery and all the baked goods made me want a whole box of sweets. I love how the characters are - and that the faith is intertwined with them. The way that the owner of the Bakery and Katie handle the break in and theft is a great reminder of God's love and unfailing Grace. I look forward to reading more from Naomi Miller and she continues on with the next installment: Christmas Cookie Mystery.

Blueberry Cupcake Mystery by Naomi Miller is technically a cozy mystery but I would even classify it further as a "sweet mystery" and not just because of all the sugary goodness from the Sweet Shop Bakery. Cozy mysteries still have a measure of violence, murder, etc. and this book doesn't have any of that. In fact, according to the Q&A at the end of the book, the author set out to write a "light mystery with a happy ending" that shows the good in people. I think she's done exactly that! It's a shorter novel, so I would almost classify it as a novella so it's a quick and easy read. In fact, the writing style is light and simple and reminded me of the tone and pace and structure of a middle grade novel. Because of this, Blueberry Cupcake Mystery is a book I would easily recommend for tweens and up. No violence, a reminder of the good of community, and the sweet tone also make this a great pick for that age group.

Bottom Line: In my opinion, the simpler writing style of Blueberry Cupcake Mystery would appeal more to a middle grade audience than an adult one, and there's not much of a mystery to speak of. It's really more about why than who, and there are none of the typical elements found in a mystery, other than the initial crime. However, the why allows Naomi Miller to envelop the story in a message of love and kindness and forgiveness, and there is a warmth to the storytelling that begs this book to be read aloud with a cluster of snuggly children and a toasty fire. Blueberry Cupcake Mystery is cute and sweet and it will make you smile. And frankly, we could all use a little more of that in our lives, couldn't we? (I received a complimentary copy of this book.)

The Blueberry Cupcake Mystery is the first in a series of books entitled "Amish Sweet Shop Mystery". Although a short read, it has all of the qualities that a good novel should exhibit!! The

setting is perfect for a cozy mystery, the Amish town of Abbott Creek, a quiet, calm place where the reader expects to feel at home immediately. Would you ever expect a crime to be committed in this delightful community?? I certainly didn't! The book captured my attention right from the mysterious burglary until the final pages when the mystery was solved. Thank goodness, this was a rather short read, as I could NOT put this book down. It kept me intrigued from beginning to end. The characters are described in such a realistic, detailed way, that I was immediately caught up in their lives. Katie was a favorite, with her eternal optimism and ability to deal with any obstacles that appeared in her path. Regardless of the bumps in her peaceful life, she always remained her sweet self and came up with solutions to solve the problems. Her willingness to forgive is an example that we all need to follow. The plot moves steadily with just enough action to keep one engrossed throughout the novel. The underlying message of compassion, forgiveness and faith clearly appears throughout the story.
